



Freelance Sample Maker

- Assist the designer and studio staff in cutting fabric, creating muslin prototypes, and sewing finished garments.

Job Responsibilities:

- Construct vintage-style garments in all stages of production, from cutting and marking to finishing work including creating sewing step-outs for videos, retreats, books, etc., as needed.
- Communicate and collaborate with designer and studio staff to meet production deadlines and follow in-house sewing practices.
- Create muslin prototypes in early stages of a design, without detailed step-by-step instructions. Identify pattern errors and communicate them to the Technical Designer with suggested corrections.
- Make pattern alterations as needed after model fittings under guidance of designer and studio staff.
- Track projects, tasks, and hours worked using Clockify time-tracking software.

Requirements:

- Extensive garment sewing experience, including in a professional setting.
- Willingness to work in Asana and Slack to communicate with the team.
- Ability to sew from home (must have essential sewing equipment).
- Must have adequate transportation to and from the sewing studio in Newburgh, NY, for picking up materials and dropping off completed projects during the studio's open hours.

Compensation:

- Starting at \$20 per hour, depending on experience.
- This is a freelance position, working from home.
